One mine drainage permit issued February 9, 1968, is partially within Mead Run Watershed and is shown on the exhibit titled "Active Mine Permit Within Mead Run Watershed".

This mine drainage permit was issued to the New Shawmut Mining Company of Saint Marys, Pennsylvania. There have been two mining permits issued. Permit 196-10 has been completed and backfilled and permit 196-11 is active with backfilling in progress. Permit 196-12 has been applied for and is currently being processed at the time of this writing. All permits have been issued for strip mine operations on the Lower Freeport or "D" Coal Seam. These permits should not be detrimental to the abatement plan within the watershed.
