## **ACTIVE MINING**

## **DEEP MINES**

The Mt. Braddock Mine is the only operating deep mine within the project area. It is owned and operated by United States Steel Corporation. The mine is located midway between Uniontown and Connellsville along the Pittsburgh Coal outcrop. The life expectancy of the mine is estimated at five years.
